Notification for Partner Selection

The National University of Political Studies and Public Administration [(Romanian: *Școala Națională de Studii Politice și Administrative* din București (SNSPA))] is a public university in Bucharest, Romania, founded in 1991.

SNSPA is a public institution of higher education and research university, which was established in 1991 as a postgraduate teaching institution, incorporating in its structure the former Faculty of High Political Studies of the University of Bucharest. In 1995, SNSPA obtained the right to organize undergraduate level training in political science and public administration and communication and public relations. SNSPA is currently a public institution of higher education subordinated to the Ministry of National Education.

SNSPA is organized into four faculties (Public Administration, Communication and Public Relations, Political Science, Management) and one department (International Relations and European Integration).

SNSPA is currently selecting a partner to develop, apply, and implement if approved, a project financed through The Romanian – EEA Research Programme 2014 – 2021. We intend to formulate through the application form submitted with our partner(s) the following draft information:

Projected title: *Transnational mobility and social inclusion of the Roma population. The mobility network between Romania and Norway.*

The project's main objective is: research and analysis of the social, political and economic factors together with the contexts that can improve the living conditions of the Roma communities engaged or just willing to engage in the transnational mobility process through social inclusion and empowerment for both Romania and Norway.

Given the complex objectives of our project, one or more partners will be selected to work with us.

Our partner(s) should be an NGO, university, research institute, private company or public institution from Romania or one of the donor countries: Norway, Island or Lichtenstein.

The partner should:

- Submit a presentation of their entity describing its activity, previous projects, employees and competences, interests and capability to share knowledge.
- Have in implementation at least one project related to Roma social research.
- Have extensive prove an experience in Roma communities and experts with a valuable contribution to Roma communities and Romani studies.

or

- Have implemented at least one project related to software development of complex predictive analysis systems.

The potential partner(s) should submit a presentation of relevant similar projects.

After the selection process, according to the call of projects, the applicant and its partner(s) will sign a partnership agreement and will work together to submit the application form for the project.
