Languages of the meeting: English, Belarusian, Georgian, Romanian, Ukrainian.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PUBLICATION

1. **Presentation of material:** An abstract should be written using MS WORD. Deadline is **October 15, 2021**. The name of the file should contain author's surname in Latin letters (for example, «Avramenko»). After sending the report by e-mail, you will receive the confirmation.

2. **Margins:** A4 with margins of 2 cm on each side

3. **Abstract length:** Page limit is **not more than 6 pages** (including reference list) in Word, Times New Roman, 12, line spacing - 1.5, paragraph - 1.25.

4. **Text:**

4.1. Page should include: name and surname (with no academic degree, title or position), name of organization, city and state should be in bold in the upper right-hand part of the page on the new line: e-mail; in the middle below – title of the report in bold (in English and Belarusian / Georgian / Romanian / Ukrainian); next line – the text (at the beginning – Introduction, then the basic text, and at the end – Conclusions and Reference List).

4.2. Reference list starts from the new paragraph, with no indentation, 14 and single space. In-text citation - in square brackets (for example: [1, p.12]) according to the reference list in alphabetical order at the end of the text.

4.3. Next line should include name and surname in bold (in English and Belarusian / Georgian / Romanian / Ukrainian), then in brackets – name of the organization, city, state, e-mail, and after brackets – title of the abstract.

5. **Information about the author.** Information about the author must be written at the end of the report (in English and Belarusian / Georgian / Romanian / Ukrainian): name and surname (in bold); full name of the organization, (city and state in brackets); home address, work address; phones (mobile, work); e-mail.

Registration form, abstract and information about the author must be in one file.

6. Authors are responsible for the completeness of the coverage of the researched issues, systematic presentation, reliability of the given facts, references to sources, writing of proper names, geographical names, etc. Compliance with the requirements for the design of the material is a prerequisite for its inclusion in the COLLECTION OF MATERIALS OF THE ROUND TABLE. Abstracts are published by the author's version.

7. Participation in the International Round Table is free of charge.
