Besides *full academic papers*, the following submissions are welcomed:

- Work in Progress: Researchers are invited to submit current projects which are either at the proposal stage or are work in progress.
- **PhD Research:** Doctoral Candidates are invited to submit papers describing their research.
- Case Study Submissions: Submissions should be written to publishable standards.

Full papers: If the abstract has been selected, papers must have between 3,000 and 4,000

words in length, including abstract, figures, references and appendices. By **June 12, 2020**, papers should be sent as .doc or .docx attachments by e-mail to strategica@facultateademanagement.ro, including in the subject of your

e-mail the track you are addressing.

All full papers will be double-blind reviewed to ensure an adequate standard, that the proposed subject of their abstract has been followed, that the paper is of a suitable length, the standard of English is adequate and the paper is appropriately referenced.
