THE RESULTS

1. THE EFFECT OF THE VIBRATION ON THE GROWTH OF THE PLANTS

The first experiment was carried out in the following manner: 100 plants of the same age and size were divided into two groups of 50 each. One group was kept in the control room and the other in the vibration room.

After 10 days the plants in the vibration room were found to be much larger and more vigorous than those in the control room. The leaves were thicker and the stems were sturdier. The plants in the vibration room also showed a more pronounced root system.

It was also found that the plants in the vibration room were more resistant to disease and insect attacks than those in the control room. This was probably due to the fact that the vibration had a stimulating effect on the plant's natural defenses.

The second experiment was carried out in a similar manner, but with a different type of vibration. In this case, the plants in the vibration room were found to be even larger and more vigorous than those in the first experiment.
